

THE ECONOMY OF FRANCESCO 2022 #EoF2022

PRESS ACCREDITATION (Asís, 22, 23 and 24 September)

The Economy of Francesco organizing committee looks forward to the arrival of 1,000 young people in Assisi and the arrival of Pope Francis to seal a pact with EoF participants for a new economy.

The schedule for the Pope's visit includes departure at 9 a.m. on the 24th from the Vatican's heliport, landing in the forecourt near the Pala eventi and the Holy Father's transfer by car to the nearby Lyrick Theater in Santa Maria degli Angeli. The Pontiff, at 10 a.m. will reach the stage where, after an artistic-cultural moment, welcome, introduction and eight testimonies from young people from all over the world, he will deliver his speech and sign the Pact with the youth of Economy to initiate the change in the economy he himself wanted.

Accreditation procedures

Journalists and media workers will be able to accredit themselves for the Holy Father's visit or for the entire "The Economy of Francesco" event by sending an e-mail request to press@francescoeconomy.org, specifying name, surname, place and date of birth, function and telephone contacts, enclosing a letter of request from the Editor-in-Chief of the media outlet, a copy of an identity document and well-defined color passport photo.

For journalists and media operators accredited to the Holy See Press Office, it will be sufficient to send their personal and telephone contact details, attaching a copy of their valid ordinary accreditation card (it will not be necessary to send a letter of request from the director of the publication).

The deadline for accreditation requests is Tuesday, September 18 at 2 p.m. and acceptance of the request will be communicated by e-mail. Accreditation cards can be collected from Wednesday, September 21, at the Lyrick Theater, (via Gabriele D'Annunzio) Santa Maria degli Angeli - Assisi, from 11:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on September 22 and 23 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon.



Press Center

A press center will be set up at the Lyrick Theater in Assisi for the three days of the event, from where it will be possible to follow the plenary sessions and the closing day with Pope Francis. Photographic images and films can be requested from Vatican Media and the Francis Economy communication office.
